Requirement:

In this project, the instructor provided (1) templates for the sizes and shapes of the records sleeves and disk labels, and (2) basic information for five singles (Record Number, Record Title, Time, Song Title, Artist and Songwriters, and Name and Year of Album). The students are required to find the above information for the sixth single. The students will create a record sleeve and two labels (A and B sides) for each of the above six singles. Each label must contain (a) logo, (b) record company name, (c) the record number, (d) the song title, (e) the artist, (f) the songwriters, and (g) the time. The sleeve contains all of the above information plus the address/website of the record company and the information on which album the songs come from. The look of each sleeve should reflect the sounds of the music but there should also be a consistent style for the label. In addition, the students are required to create a logo for the fictitious music records company RadioActive from one of the ten initial design concepts, to be attached to the sleeves and the labels.

Design Strategy Used:

In this project, I choose to use the following graphic elements to reflect the essential spirit of the music, and the general mood or style is "fresh" or "happy" in terms of aesthetics. These graphic elements come from (1) screenshots of scenes, props, and images of the singers, from YouTube videos featuring the singles' music, or (2) Google Image Search of digital photos of topics related to words from the lyrics. These graphic elements are composed in Adobe Photoshop to create digital illustrations. The stories of the singers and of the musical teams they are associated with, the "Official Videos" of their performance, and the lyrics of their songs, have been studied, in order to understand their historical settings, and to create illustrations that reflect the deep meanings in their musical creation and performance. For fonts, Snap ITC Regular is used for all Records Titles; and Tw Cen MT Condensed Extra Bold is used for all other texts.
